Guidelines/Expectations:

- Masks will be required by staff, students, and parents while on school property.
 - Students will be required to have a brief 5-question health screening prior to getting a physical.
 - Student-Athletes will be health screened outside in the quad before entering the building. A separate area will used for screening purposes to maintain confidentiality.
 - Parents will not be permitted to enter the building. If a parent(s) wishes to come into the building then they too will have to be screened prior to entry into the facility.
 - This screening was established by CHSAA (Colorado High School Activities Association) to address symptoms of Covid-19.
 - Through this screening process, a "yes" to two or more questions and the individual(s) may not participate in receiving a physical.
- Social distancing precautions will be taken. Designated markers will be placed on the ground in order to maintain 6ft. of separation.
- Physical packets will be available and must be signed by the parent/guardian and turned in to the designated table.
 - Please bring your own pen in order to fill out the packet
 - If you do not have a pen there will be a limited number, however for sanitary purposes if you could please bring your own pen please do so.
- Once the physical is completed, please leave school grounds as to limit the number of people on campus.
- Please come at your designated grade level time.
- Sports schedules will NOT be available at this time.
